

Maths Challenge


Same-Sum Circles

Notice that the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 are placed the in three circles below. The sum of the numbers in each circle is 12.



Question 1: Can you move the numbers around so that the sum in each circle is 13? (You must still have exactly 1 copy of each number.)

Question 2 (for experts): What other sums can you make? What is the largest possible sum? Can you make every sum from 12 up to that number?
