Advice regarding self-isolation

You need to take action to isolate if:

- · I or a member of my household has Covid -19 symptoms
- · I or a member of my household is awaiting a test result
- · I or a member of my household has received a positive Covid-19 test result
- (regardless of if you or the family member have symptoms)

What does self-isolation mean for a household that has a family member with symptoms or a confirmed case?

- Your whole household needs to isolate and not leave the family home.
- Nobody outside of the family bubble should enter the home.

You also need to take action to isolate if:

- · If you have been asked by Track and Trace to isolate
- \cdot $\,$ You have received a letter from your child's school or activity club asking them to self-isolate.

What does self-isolation mean for a household with a family member who has been a close contact?

- The person that has been asked to isolate cannot leave the family home until the return to normal activities date detailed in any correspondence provided.
- Nobody outside of the family bubble should enter the home.
- \cdot Other household members do not need to self-isolate unless they are also a close contact.

We are asking you to do this to reduce the further spread of Covid-19, to friends, family and our wider school community.
