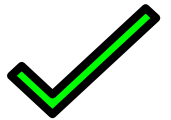

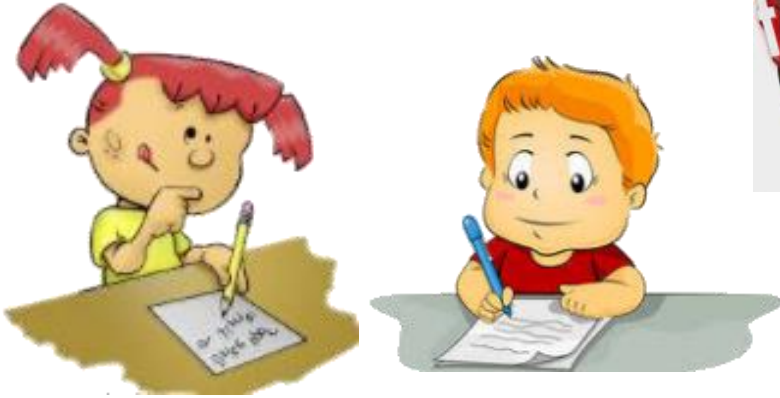

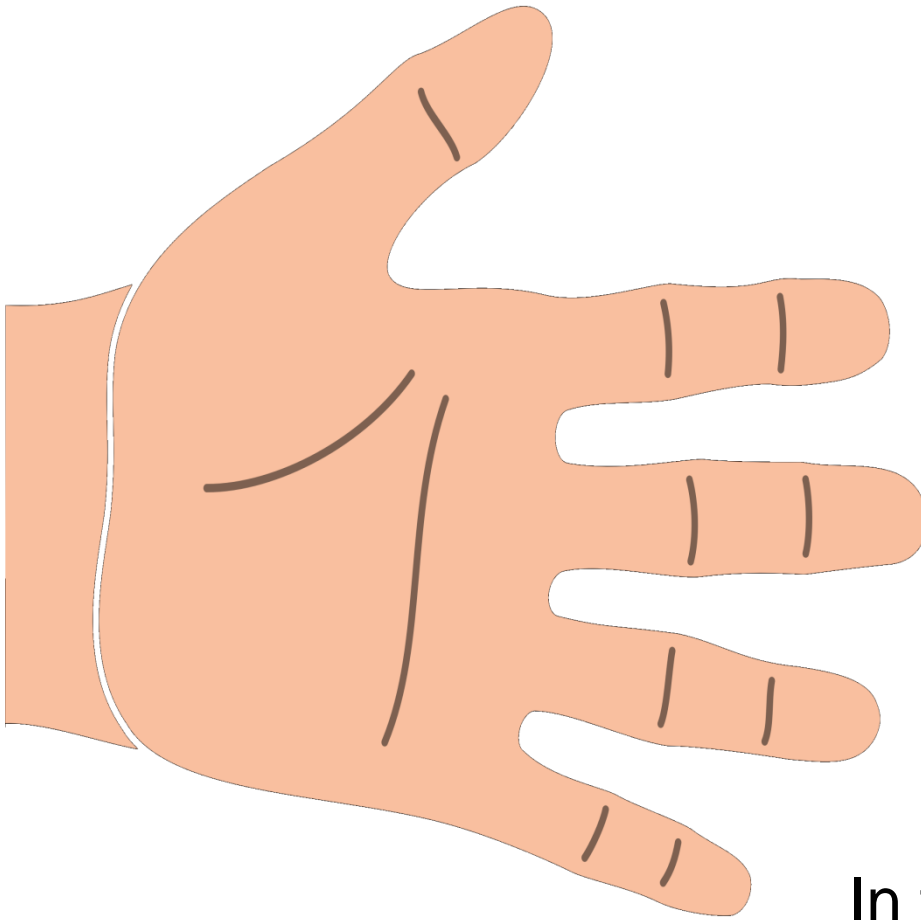
A person writes instructions to help the reader understand what they are making and how to do it.

The reader uses instructions to help make something. They need to know what they will need and what order to do things in.

Hi 5 instructions!

*children physically put their hand in the air, saying aloud each part as they pinch the corresponding finger.

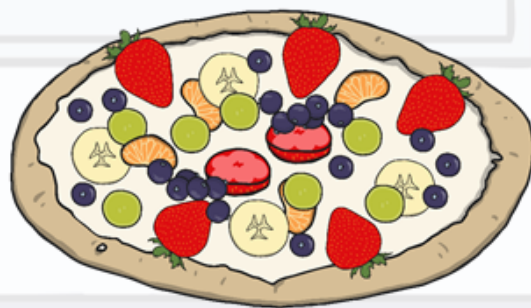
How To Make Fruit Pizzas

You will need:

- Digestive biscuits
- Natural yoghurt
- 3 – 4 different types of fruit e.g. Apple, banana, grapes, orange
- Plate
- Spreading knife
- Sharpe knife
- A grown up!

What to do:

- First, place your biscuits on the plate.
- Then, spread the yogurt onto the biscuit.
- Carefully cut up the fruit into small pieces. (Ask a grown up to help you with the sharp knife)
- Finally, put the fruit on top of the yogurt.
- Enjoy!



Top Tip:

Keep the fruit pizzas in the fridge once made.

1. Mix the butter and sugar.
