A big welcome back! We hope you had a wonderful Christmas break surrounded by family and friends and wish you lots of good health and happiness for 2022. We have lots of exciting things planned for this coming term and ask for your continued help in ensuring that the children have reading records, homework books and library books in school on the required day. Reading records with four reads recorded should be handed in every Monday, homework books on Thursday and if your child has a Read, Write Inc. book this should be changed after reading it through three times. In English, we will be writing a suspense story based on the story of The Wolves in the Walls. We will also be writing a fantasy story based on a Pixar animation and be doing some non-fiction writing based on the Street Beneath My Feet.

In maths we will begin with consolidating multiplication and division. Year 3 will then move into measurement (money) and statistics. In March and April we will look at measuring length and fractions.

In science we will be looking at rocks, soils and fossils.

Music: Instrumental and vocal skills - creating rhythmic and melodic patterns using the ukuleles and glockenspiels with Mr Hopkins.
