Girls – Day Wear
Black shoes; flat soles with grip or plain simple black boots during the winter months *
Grey trousers, grey tailored shorts, grey pinafore or grey skirt **
White polo shirt (with or without logo) or white shirt with collar
Purple and white check summer dress or purple and white check summer all-in-one skort
Plain grey tights, plain white socks or grey socks
Purple sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
Girls – PE Wear
Trainers (coloured allowed) or plimsolls for dance and gym (barefoot otherwise)
Plain black PE shorts, black leggings or black tracksuit bottom
Purple PE t-shirt (with logo)

Notes:


- * No sandals or open toe shoes. No fur trims or heels on boots

- Jewellery: only single, stud pierced earrings and no bracelets, bands or necklaces
- On PE days, please remove stud earrings before coming to school. No watches during the PE lesson.
- Hair: long hair to be tied back with a plain hair band.
 No big bows (e.g. Jojo bows) and no hair dye.
- No make-up, nail varnish or transfer tattoos
- Watches may be worn but we cannot take any responsibility for loss or damage. No Smart Watches.
- Only pupils in Years 5 and 6 may bring a mobile phone to school and only after requesting and receiving permission from the Headteacher. Phones will be kept securely in the main office during the school day.
