What is Child Protection about?

All of the adults around you think keeping you happy, healthy and safe are very important.

In our school, we respect all children and we do our best to help children make good educational progress.

We also teach children how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

How do we try to protect children?

We try to provide a safe environment for children to learn in.

We listen to children if they have concerns or worries.

We want children to feel safe at home as well as at school

We think it is important for children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something (at home or in school).

Need to talk?

You can talk to any adult in school if you need to – anyone you feel comfortable talking to!

This could be any teacher, teaching assistant, Mrs Pike or Mr Hughes.

There is also **Childline** – a charity which has people who are trained to talk to worried children.
