

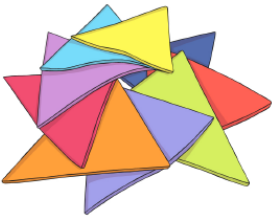

There are many different types of fabric. We will be using **felt** to make animal puppets.



Felt can be made from natural fibres such as wool or unnatural fibres such as acrylic.



When one shape of fabric is sewn on top of another piece of fabric it is called **appliqué**.

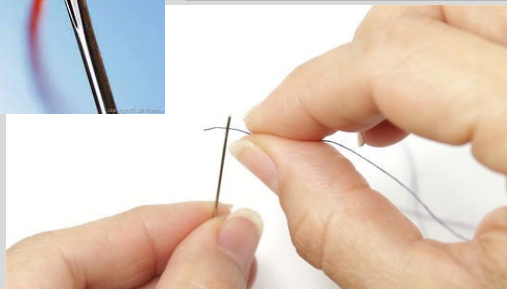

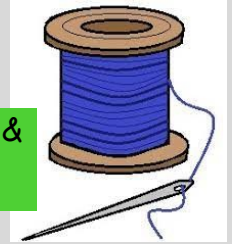


Felt animal puppets

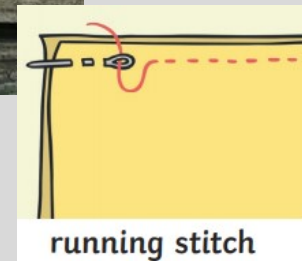
The thread goes through the **eye** of the needle.



Needle & thread



We can join fabric by using glue. We can also use a needle and thread to stitch the pieces of fabric together.



We will use a **running stitch** which is where you push the needle and thread in and out of the fabric.

Some people use a **thimble** when they are sewing to protect their finger from the needle.
