### Our learning this week:


Ahoy there shipmates! We have really enjoyed our boats theme this week. We loved being super scientists exploring floating and sinking. The children made super predictions using their sentence stem "I think.....because..."

"I think it will sink because it is heavy." "I think it will float because it is inflatable." At the end of the week we had an

exciting message arrive in a bottle from



Pirate Pete. He needed help from the children to find his treasure. We used our Red Words go to the to write some instructions for him. Look at our amazing writing:



We found out that Pirates DO NOT share! The children are becoming real experts at sharing and were keen to lend a hand following the rules: I. Carefully count out your starting number. 2. Give each person I at a time until they are all gone. 3. Count how many each person has and check it is an even/equal number. Whilst we were doing this we discovered that not all numbers can share equally – we used the word 'odd' to describe this number. Some of the children went on to investigate which numbers to IO could share and which could not.

## Nuffield Early Language Intervention:



Thanks to Department for Education funding, all children in Reception have had a language assessment on entry to Reception this year. Those children who were assessed as needing additional support with their language skills have since received small group or one to one support in school since January. In order to assess the impact of the programme we will be completing a final assessment of all our Reception children (this is delivered via an interactive and engaging iPad app). We are participating in an Impact Evaluation of this programme which is being carried out by the National Foundation for Educational Research (NFER). Your child brought home a letter earlier this week containing more detail about this. If you are happy for your child's data to be used for this evaluation, you do not need to return the reply slip. Please do come and speak to us if you need any further information.

#### Our learning next week:

The children are loving the theme of Pirates so much we are going to extend this topic into next week.

We will have a focus on super sentence writing ensuring the children are using a capital letter at the start, a full stop at the end and leaving spaces between their words to make it easy to read.

We are going to practise counting aloud above 20 and when looking at a number square to 100 we will notice patterns e.g. 10, 20, 30, 40 ..... repetition of 1–9 within 2 digit numbers. Please see the printable 100 square for you to use at home to practise this with your child.
